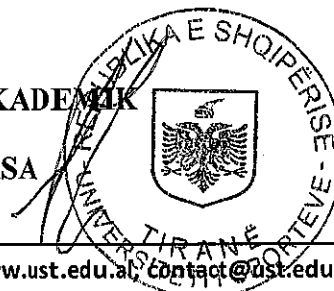

CHAPTER I

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Article 1

Description of the Study Programme

These Regulations refer to the Master's Degree Programme in *Rehabilitation Sciences of Health Professions*, established within the School of Medicine and Surgery of the University of Studies "Magna Graecia" of Catanzaro.

The Regulations define the organization, content, functioning and development of the Master's Degree Programme, in compliance with:

- academic autonomy;
- freedom of teaching;
- the rights and duties of academic staff and students;
- the national legal framework and the University regulations.

The Programme belongs to Class LM/SNT2 – **Rehabilitation Sciences of Health Professions**, pursuant to the Ministerial Decree of 8 January 2009.

CHAPTER II

ADMISSION AND ENROLMENT

Article 2

Admission to the Master's Degree Programme

1. Admission to the Master's Degree Programme is subject to a **limited number of places**, in accordance with Law No. 264/1999.
2. Admission is granted through an **admission examination**, consisting of a multiple-choice test.
3. For admission purposes, the candidate's academic and professional qualifications may also be taken into consideration.
4. Enrolment requires:
 - o a Bachelor's Degree in Class L/SNT2, or an equivalent qualification under the legislation in force;
 - o a university diploma qualifying for the practice of a rehabilitation health profession.
5. The professional profiles include, among others:
 - o physiotherapist,
 - o speech and language therapist,
 - o occupational therapist,
 - o neuro- and psychomotor therapist,
 - o orthoptist,
 - o psychiatric rehabilitation technician,
 - o podiatrist,
 - o professional educator.

The maximum number of students admitted each year is established by Decree of the competent Ministry, in cooperation with the Calabria Region and the Ministry of Health.

CHAPTER III

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES AND PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

Article 3

Educational Objectives

The Master's Degree Programme aims to train rehabilitation professionals with advanced clinical, managerial, organizational, educational and research skills.

Graduates shall be able to:

- organize and manage rehabilitation services;
- manage human and technological resources;

- coordinate multidisciplinary teams;
- assess the quality of healthcare services;
- develop and implement research projects;
- perform managerial and academic functions;
- participate in competitive examinations for Doctoral (PhD) programmes.

CHAPTER IV

CREDITS AND STRUCTURE OF STUDIES

Article 4

University Educational Credits (CFU)

1. The Master's Degree Programme comprises **120 CFU**, distributed over **two academic years**.
2. One CFU corresponds to **25 hours of student workload**, including:
 - lectures,
 - seminars,
 - tutorial activities,
 - professional training placements,
 - individual study,
 - elective activities.
3. Credits are awarded upon successful completion of the relevant examinations.

CHAPTER V

STUDY PLAN

Article 5

Didactic Framework and Study Plan

The study plan defines:

- teaching activities,
- scientific-disciplinary sectors,
- the corresponding credits.

For integrated courses, a Coordinator is appointed, who is responsible for didactic organization, examinations and the achievement of the educational objectives.

CHAPTER VI
CONDITIONS FOR PROGRESSION

Article 6

Prerequisites and Limitations

- Progression to the following academic year requires the acquisition of at least **50% of the annual CFU**.
- Failure to pass any examination for **three consecutive academic years** results in the loss of student status.

CHAPTER VII
TEACHING METHODS

Article 8

Teaching Formats

Teaching activities include:

- frontal lectures,
- seminars,
- tutorial activities,
- supervised professional training,
- elective activities (6 CFU),
- independent study.

Professional training is compulsory and may not be replaced by employment activities.

CHAPTER VIII
ATTENDANCE AND EXAMINATIONS

Article 9

Attendance

Attendance is compulsory. A **minimum attendance of 75%** is required in order to be admitted to examinations.

Article 10

Examinations

- Each integrated course provides for a **single examination**.
- Marks are expressed on a **thirty-point scale (out of 30)**.
- **Four examination sessions** are scheduled during the academic year.

CHAPTER IX

FINAL EXAMINATION

Article 11

Thesis and Degree Award

1. The final examination consists of the preparation and defence of a **scientific thesis**.
2. The thesis is evaluated by an Examination Committee.
3. The final degree mark is expressed out of **110 points**, with the possibility of awarding **Honours (Lode)**.

CHAPTER X

FINAL PROVISIONS

Articles 12–16

These articles govern:

- recognition of previous studies,
- governing bodies,
- quality assurance,
- periodic evaluation,
- the information portal,
- transitional provisions.
